## Assessment & Award Regulations

<b>11.</b>	<b>Classification and Award of Degree</b>
11.1.	A candidate who, at the first attempt, obtains an average mark of between 65 – 74% will be awarded Pass with Merit.
11.2.	A candidate who, at the first attempt, obtains an average mark of 75% or more will be awarded Pass with Distinction.
<b>12.</b>	<b>Disclosure of Marks</b>
	Results will be published by candidate number.
<b>13.</b>	<b>Absence From In-Course Assessment</b>
13.1.	Where a student has an allowable absence, s/he will be marked absent from the in course module assessment. Where a student has been absent the overall mark will be calculated pro rata from the remaining assessments.
13.2.	An allowable absence is one that is for a significant unforeseeable event such as illness. Any other foreseeable absence will only be considered allowable if agreed by the Student Performance and Development System (formerly Academic Progress Committee) and this will only apply in very strictly limited circumstances.
13.3.	A student absent for any other reason will be awarded 0 for the assessment.
